

Product features



Four way solution

Four electronic locking modes: master PIN code/user PIN code, key card, APP and fingerprint.



Master PIN code/ User PIN code/ Key card/ and Fingerprint identification



1 master PIN code, up to 10 user PIN codes, 1 temporary user PIN code, 100 key cards, 100 fingerprints.





Random security coding function

The random number can be added before or after the real user PIN code but the maximum length is 32 digits. This feature will prevent the real user PIN code from being exposed.



Auto lock / Auto re-lock function

When the door is closed, the lock will lock automatically (In case of auto locking mode).



Burglary alarm function

When the door is opened by force, the lock is suspended with alarm.



Prevent mischief and hacking

When entering 5 times a wrong user PIN code/fingerprint and card in 5 minutes, the lock is suspended 100 seconds. After that the lock will activate again. While the lock is suspended, the screen will flash when you are trying to use keypad.



Alarm for battery replacement time

When the power of battery is too low a warning signal will appear on the screen. Please replace all batteries immediately.



- * If there is a low battery alert, please replace all the batteries in time and make sure they are properly installed.



- 4. Temporary user PIN code(6-12 digits): Maximum capacity is 1, this PIN can only be used for one time unlocking.
- 5. Fingerprint: Maximum capacity is 100 with user number [00-99].
- 6. Card: Maximum capacity is 100 with user number [00-99].

How to pairing remote control:



 After select "Join network", use a paper clip to press [Set] button on the back of remote controller. Then it will go to pairing mode at the moment, then the indicator will always light Blue.




2. Press [Unlock] button of remote controller to finish operation

Succeed: LED indicator falshes

Green light twice.

Failed: LED indicator falshes

Red light twice.



Reset button

Delete all paired devices:

While the module is installed on lock and powered on, press and hold the [Reset] button on remote module by a paper clip for at least 3 seconds. After that, all paired remote controllers will be deleted.



- 2. Please enabling the Bluetooth first, before you manage Bluetooth. And please keep it is turned on, when you use it.


Auto/Manual mode



- 1. Remove battery cover to find the A/M switch.
- 2. [A] means auto mode: when door is closed, the deadbolt will drive out automatically, the door will be in locked status.
- 3. [M] means manual mode: when door is closed, the deadbolt will not drived out, then the door will be in unlocked status.



How to open the door from inside



Mechanical key

Use mechanical key to unlock.

How to lock the door

Auto locking mode: After close the door, the deadbolt will come out automatically

Manual locking mode:



Close the door and verify the PIN code/ fingerprint/ key card to lock the door.

Micro USB emergency power supply



Micro USB emergency power supply




When the battery voltage is too low and cannot be opened from outside, connect a 5V power supply via Micro USB port at the front. Then unlock the door and replace all batteries immediately.

Reboot button



Press the reboot button to restart the lock when the system is unresponsive, no user data is deleted.

Reset to factory default settings



↑ CAUTION All user data will be deleted!


Operation instructions:

- 1. Open battery cover and find the reset button.
- 2. Double click [RES] button, then voice prompt "Restored to factory settings. Change master PIN code."
- 3. After that all user data and settings will be deleted.


(A CAUTION

- 1. This remote controller uses RF 433MHz for communication with remote module.
- 2. Each remote controller can be paired with multiple modules, and control them at the same time.
- 3. Each remote module can pair with maximum 21 pcs remote controllers.
- 4. Theoretical remote range in open space is more than 40 meters. But it might be affected by walls in the building.

Expansion bolt 2pcs

Unlock succeed: LED indicator flashes **Green** twice. Unlock failed: LED indicator flashes

Red twice.



Press re-lock button to re-lock

Re-lock succeed: LED indicator flashes **Green** twice.

Re-lock failed: LED indicator flashes **Red** twice.



Replace battery



1. Unfasten 2 screws




2. Remove cover from bottom



3. Replace battery



4. Replace cover



5. Fasten 2 screws
